Workshop 5: Reflecting on British & European Culture All-Day Visit To London British Museum: Grayson Perry Exhibition (Turner prize Winner) & Practical Artist Led Workshop based on the collection Visit to Covent Garden Recording images of British Culture (Flip Cameras) in preparation for tomorrow’s workshop</p>
Wednesday 16 November	<p>AM: 8.30 – 8.50 Workshop 6: Culture through Film Presentation using different portrayals of British and European identities through film and documentary.</p> <p>8.50 – 12.50 Workshop 6: Film Making Students share any preparatory work that has been completed for this in terms of script ideas exploring the theme of Identity and Difference.</p> <p>Working in School groups students develop their ideas to create either a documentary film (using the Wycliffe Campus) or live performance. Choice of making a documentary-style video about impressions of British and European culture, or developing a drama scene about the same.</p> <p>2.00 – 4.00 Rehearsals / editing</p> <p>4.00 – 5.00 Free Time</p> <p>5.15 – 6.30 Additional editing / rehearsal time</p> <p>7.00 – 8.30 Presentation Students present selected creative writing pieces produced prior to the event. Students perform their drama scenes / show films (if editing completed) to Year 9 and 10 audience.</p>
